

Comprehensive and Team-Based

The Saint Luke Institute Candidate Assessment Program is comprehensive and involves a team of three professionals.

Pre-assessment Personal Profile and Spirituality Profile

Two questionnaires completed prior to the on-site assessment

Clinical and Psychosocial Interviews

 Series of interviews with two different trained professionals to explore and understand the candidate's psychological and psychosocial profile

Spiritual Assessment

 In-depth interview with a spiritual formator to identify the candidate's current religious beliefs, practices and understanding of the discernment process

Intellectual and Psychological Testing

- Intelligence testing to obtain a current measure of intellectual functioning
- Personality testing to better understand the candidate's personality profile and general mental health



Feedback

- One-hour meeting with the assessment team, candidate and formation or vocation director to discuss the results
- Detailed written report sent to the candidate and the formation or vocation director within two weeks

- confidential: as mental health providers and spiritual formators, we respect the confidential nature of the assessment process.
