These tests need to be completed the week before your scheduled Zoom meetings. You will receive an administration email for each test with a **link** to start the test.

Once you access the **link** for the test, make sure that you read the instructions carefully and answer all the questions.

The **NEO PI-3** test could take up to 90 minutes to complete. You will receive an invitation email with the following instruction from Pariconnect.com:
