

EDUCATION: GROWING OUR REACH

SLIconnect is the education ministry of Saint Luke Institute, supporting the psychological and spiritual health of men and women serving in the Catholic Church.

Through SLIconnect clergy, religious, and lay leaders around the world access practical, skills-based courses. Our content encourages self-care and development, nourishes life-giving relationships, and cultivates an effective ministry that can navigate our culture's most challenging situations with grace and love.

Reach

In 2021, we served 6,117 participants with our online education offerings. Our reach is international, with people joining us from Australia, India, Ireland, Italy, and New Zealand, as well as the United States.

In April 2022, we look forward to resuming in-person teaching with the fourth biennial Conference on Human Formation in St. Meinrad, Indiana. The series returns to the topic of initial and ongoing celibacy formation for the priesthood and religious life. Presenters will offer skills and resources needed to prepare men and women for the charism of celibate chastity.

Programs

The world is different as we continue to navigate the COVID-19 pandemic. So, this year we offered several new programs to help ministers guide their constituents through these turbulent times and provide support, encouragement, and coping skills for our leaders.

- *Mental Health Matters* – This live virtual event took place in March and April 2021 and was one of our most successful webinar series to date, with more than 185 participants. Now available on-demand, the eight-hour series helps participants address mental health challenges that can arise among men and women pursuing the priesthood, religious life, and ministry in the Church.

Our free program offerings also continue to bless our community with wisdom and understanding.

- *Humility in Eucharistic Ministry and Devotion* – More than 240 registered to participate live, and another 100+ have listened on-demand, as Father David Songy explores the divine gift of Eucharistic humility.
- *Grace & Bias: Forming Catholic Leaders Around Issues of Race* – A generous grant allowed us to offer this three-part series for free. More than 300 individuals participated in each session. The series explores issues of implicit bias, creating a safe space to have a dialogue about racism, and theological reflection on how we can overcome racism in our own hearts and the hearts of others.

Impact

The flexibility of the SLIconnect platform served our constituents well in a time when in-person education halted in many organizations. Fortunately, we already knew how to deliver content online and had little to change when challenging times hit.

Our number of group subscriptions to SLIconnect has more than doubled since launching in 2016. Subscribers include archdioceses, religious communities, seminaries, and formators groups, and they use the content in myriad ways:


What a difference a year makes. The pandemic is not over, and it continues to affect many aspects of our daily lives. Yet, Father David's encouraging meditation on Isaiah 43:19 from last year's annual report still resonates today.

Saint Luke Institute has undertaken several new initiatives in its advancement efforts. These efforts are now reaping a harvest in our ability to prevent and intervene in mental health concerns and provide best-in-class treatment for clergy, religious, seminarians, and vocational candidates.


In the past 24 months, between June 2019 and June 2021, our donor base has increased by 370 percent. Two factors account for this increase. One, an intentional strategy was implemented to introduce active Catholics to the mission and ministry of Saint Luke Institute through robust direct mail campaigns that focused on Candidate Assessments. Second, the Annual Benefit was held virtually last year and invited a national audience to tune in for the first time. And, I would be remiss if I did not mention the feet-on-the-ground efforts by our staff who have tirelessly amplified our mission and vision throughout the communities we serve.

Candidate Assessment

SLI continues its important work in ensuring that healthy and holy men and women are prepared for ecclesiastic ministry through its Candidate Assessment program. Dr. Emily Cash shares her insight on conducting Candidate Assessments in a newly produced video, *Life Giving Insight for the Formation Journey*. SLI's team approach to Candidate Assessments is one unique feature of our process. A three-person interdisciplinary team assesses each candidate for the permanent diaconate, priesthood, and religious life over two days. Candidates are administered personality and cognitive testing, and participate in clinical, psychological, and spiritual evaluations. Then, we share comprehensive verbal and written reports with the candidate and their diocese, seminary, or religious order so that together, they can make a more informed and supportive decision about the candidate's future.

Which Opportunity Is Best for You?

Donor Advised Funds

A donor advised fund (DAF) is a philanthropic giving vehicle that provides an immediate tax benefit to individuals while creating a way to support charities like Saint Luke Institute by directing grants at a later time. Increasingly, many supporters of Saint Luke Institute donate through their DAF.

Stocks and Bonds

Gifts of long-term, appreciated stocks and bonds can provide a double benefit: donors may be eligible for both a charitable tax deduction for the value of the securities on the day of transfer, and they may not be responsible for taxes on any gains from the time the stock was acquired. Contact the development office for transfer instructions and more information.

Charitable IRA Transfers

Donors age 70 ½ or older can transfer a contribution each year directly from a traditional IRA account. This may satisfy a portion or all of the annual required minimum distribution and serve as a qualified charitable distribution, which can decrease tax burdens even for the non-itemizing taxpayer.


