The position involves -

- Participating as a member of the multidisciplinary team in our intensive outpatient program, serving as a primary therapist, conducting process groups, and psychoeducation groups.
- Conducting and chairing psychological evaluations (in person and virtually) as part of an interdisciplinary team assessing clients undergoing a five-day comprehensive psychological and spiritual evaluation for seminarians, clergy, and men and women religious. The evaluation process results in an informed diagnosis with corresponding recommendations.
- Conducting in-depth, multi-day psychological assessments for candidates for the permanent diaconate, priesthood, and religious life for vocational suitability as part of an interdisciplinary team.
- Conducting individual, outpatient therapy with Catholic priests, religious, seminarians, and lay persons in person and via telehealth.

Qualifications

- Must have Ph.D. or Psy.D., in counseling or clinical psychology.
- Must have a current license to practice psychology in Maryland. Licensure in Washington, DC and PSYPACT is a plus.
- At least three (3) years of experience in a mental health or counseling environment.
- Proficiency in interpretation of psychological testing including the MMPI-3, MCMI-IV, NEO-PI-3, and Rorschach (RPAS preferred). Basic understanding of cognitive and neuropsychological testing a plus.
- Experience with both individual therapy and psychological assessment.
- Must have strong verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills.
- Must have the ability to utilize computer systems and software necessary to perform position functions.
- Bi-lingual (Spanish speaking) a plus.
- Must have strong problem-solving skills and good judgment.
- Must be organized and detail oriented.
