Those ministers who enter our five-day-a-week, multi-month treatment program encounter our dedicated clinicians and spiritual caregivers who, in the healing spirit of Christ, carefully and lovingly bring them back to balance, and to their true selves. They receive licensed therapeutic care, new skills, and renewed hope to enable coping, recovery with confidence, and a return to active ministry.

The new name for our professional, clinically- and spiritually-focused and highly successful therapeutic day-treatment program, based out of our Silver Spring, Maryland location, underlines the same comprehensive care we have always provided, while highlighting its connection to the journey to wholeness expressed in the Emmaus encounter.

In addition, our integrated care model includes:

- Initial assessment and treatment recommendations
- Options for community housing, meals and prayer among welcoming religious houses for women and men in the Greater Washington, DC area
- Likely savings of thousands of dollars and greater support in transition back to ministry when compared to a residential program, even when housing costs are considered
- Further savings possible through insurance reimbursement
- Easy private car, public transit, and ride share accessibility to our Silver Spring office suite
